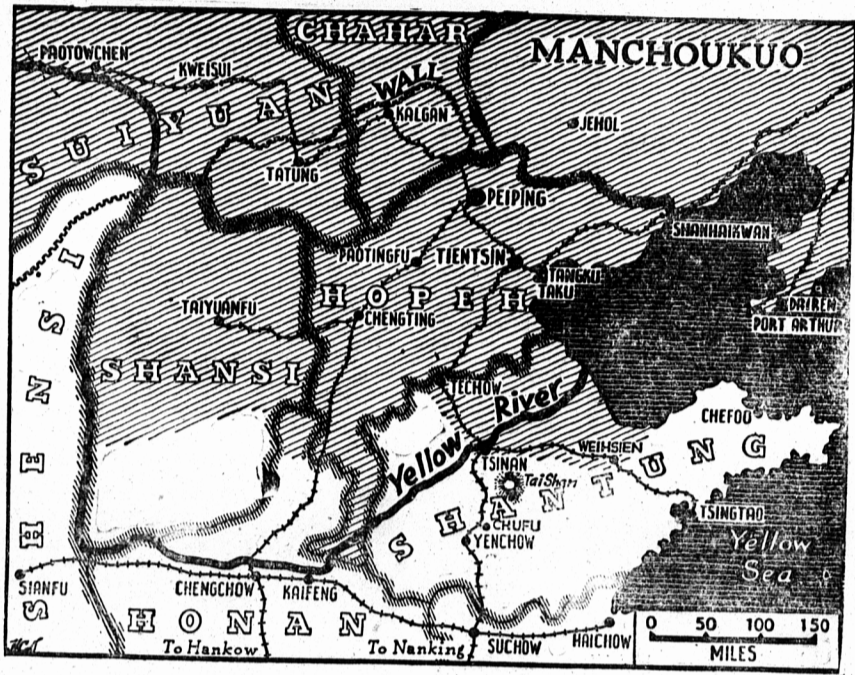
CABINET REVIEWS FAR EAST SITUATION

CHAMBERLAIN MEETS WITH KEY MINISTERS

Japanese Demands For Extended Control In Shanghai Discussed.

(C. P. by Guardian's Special Wire) LONDON, Jan. 10—Prime Minister Chamberlain today conferred with key cabinet ministers and a former Ambassador to China as he reviewed extensively the position that has developed over Japanese demands for permanent changes in administration of Shanghai's International Settlement.

The extent to which Japanese armies have moved southward into Shantung province is indicated in this map, with shaded areas also showing areas as already under Japanese domination in Suiyuan, Chahar, Hopen and Shansi provinces. With the capture of Tsinan, Shantung's capital, and Selhsien, strategic rail city, the Japanese have isolated Tsingtao. Now the war machine is approaching the "Holy Land of China," including Chufu, birthplace of Confucius, and Tai Shan, the sacred mountain of China.

RELIEF COSTS CITY \$5,000 IS REPORT

City Purchases Truck And Snow Plow—Annual Meeting Of Council Scheduled For Jan. 27.

Direct relief had cost the City approximately \$5,000 since it was started last month. Coun. G. W. McLeod, chairman of the finance committee informed the City Council at the regular monthly meeting last night. Of that amount \$2,200 had been for coal. The figures included what had been spent in December and to date in January.

Purchase of a Fargo truck with Sargent plow complete, attached, at a cost of \$3,270 from F. B. McLaine was decided on by the Council. The machine would be used for clearing city streets of snow and, as the plow is detachable, the truck can be used for regular city trucking. The present small plow had outlived its usefulness to a great extent, Coun. A. A. Hennessey, chairman of the street committee, said. Heavier equipment was necessary to keep streets open during snow storms to permit passage of fire trucks. Purchase of the truck was on a tender basis.

The tender of A. Pickard & Co. for 50 tons of slack coal, Indian Cove, at \$5.35 per ton delivered, for the Market Building and Library was accepted. The supplying of 125 tons of Springhill coal for the City Building was equally divided between W. D. Gillis & Co., A. Pickard & Co., Lyons & Co., and H. R. Large & Co. The price was \$8.00 per ton delivered. T. M. MacMillan and R. P. Forsythe, City Auditors, and James E. Bradley, sanitary officer, were re-appointed at the meeting. First reading was given a by-law respecting a restricted building zone. Second reading would be given at the next meeting of the Council, whether special or regular, it was announced.

C. N. R. Bond Issue Quickly Subscribed

OTTAWA, Jan. 10—Speedy sale of \$50,000,000 in Dominion government-guaranteed Canadian National Railway bonds and the entry of Camille Houde in the Montreal St. Henri by-election were matters of outstanding interest in Ottawa today. Subscription books for the Canadian National bond issue opened at nine a. m. today and were closed by order of Finance Minister Duggan at 10.15 a. m. with disposal of the entire issue. The proceeds will go to reimburse the government for advances to the railways since 1932.

Archaeologist Shot By Arab Bandits

JERUSALEM, Jan. 10—Arab bandits today shot and killed Professor J. L. Starkey, noted British archaeologist, near his camp at Tel Duweir. His two assistants, unharmed, sent back word that the bandits forced the explorer from his automobile and shot him in the back. It was believed robbery was the motive. Professor Starkey worked on the Tel Duweir excavations for several years as head of the Wellcome Archaeological Research Expedition. In 1934 he made discoveries of great importance at the site, which was identified as the ancient Biblical city of Lachish.

JANUARY TERM OF COURT WILL OPEN TODAY

Justice A. E. Arsenault To Preside In Absence Of Chief Justice Mathieson.

One hundred and twenty nuns and 150 pupils were removed safely.

"Mountie" Attends U.S. Police Academy

WASHINGTON, Jan. 10—A tall, handsome "Mountie" from northern Saskatchewan today joined the United States Federal Bureau of Investigation National Police Academy. It was the first occasion a foreign police force has been represented at the academy and John Edgar Hoover, chief of the G-men, took the opportunity to especially welcome him. Emperor Summons Leaders To Chart Course Of War In China

(A.P. By Guardian's Special Wire) TOKYO, Jan. 10—The third conference before the Emperor in Japanese history today was summoned to chart the future course of Japan's six-months-old, but still not declared war against China. A formal declaration of war was one of the steps reported against China. Tokyo newspapers said Admiral Nobunama Suetanagu, Home Minister, was insisting on formal declaration of war and withdrawal of recognition of the Chinese Government. Domei, Japanese news agency, reported Ambassador Shigeru Kawaguchi was expected to be notified of the Emperor's decision.

Flames Prevent Rescue Attempt Ranchers Report

Tragedy Occurs Over Montana Timberlands—Well Known Canadian Among Victims Believed

BOZEMAN, Mont., Jan. 10—(CP)—A Northwest Airlines plane, long overdue at Billings, Mont., with Douglas Mackay of Winnipeg and nine others aboard, was reported by two ranchers today to have crashed in the snow-covered timber country northwest of here and burst into flames. The ranchers, C. A. Larson and Glenn White, said they saw the plane spin to earth 14 miles from Bozeman where they were cutting timber. Flames, they said, prevented an attempt to rescue those aboard the plane.

Bozeman, capital of Gallatin County, is 98 miles south-east of Helena, the state capital and some 360 miles south of the border, about due south of Medicine Hat, Alberta. The Northwest Airlines said the plane carried six passengers and four company employees. At the company's St. Paul, Minn., office a passenger list showed D. Mackay of the Hudson's Bay Company of Winnipeg.
