The British Economic Conference

Its Purpose the Commercial Union of the British Empire.

Closer Commercial relations between the Mother Country and the British Dominions throughout the world is now a prime subject of discussion all over the Empire.

For example, the London Daily Telegraph in a leading article headed "Our Best Customers" strongly favors British Commercial Union.

There is no doubt whatever that the representatives of Australia, New Zealand, South Africa, Newfoundland and India will "play the game" in the interests of Inter-imperial trade, prosperity and independence.

Referring to a measure recently passed by the Parliament of Great Britain, the London Daily Telegraph says: "The Empire Settlement Act might be more accurately described as the Empire Development Act, and it is in that sense as the President of the Board of Trade indicated that the British Government, realizing what can be done with the annual grant of £3,000,000 is interpreting it.
