TORONTO, Dec 22—A gigantic railway project has been launched at Edmonton to open up the Athabasca and Peace River sections. A charter has been granted to the Northern Empire Railway, and the Manitoba and British Columbia Railway. Companies have been transferred to the new company headed by Henry Roy, a millionaire, and the company is capitalized at four and a half millions.

The company will ask for a government guarantee of the bonds for the line north and south of Edmonton. One line will run through Peace River across the mountains and terminate at Dawson. A branch also projected to the east from McMurray to Fort Churchill on Hudson's Bay.

BERLIN, Dec 22—Princess Anna of Lowenstein Wertheim has patented under the name of Karma an invention to prevent seasickness by keeping the berths horizontal however the ship may roll.

The device is maintained by gimbal-like similar to those in marine compasses, but the princess also employs magnets and electricity. She believes the principle is adaptable to guns on warships and to operating tables in hospital ships.

FISHERMAN HAD NARROW ESCAPE

LOUISBURG, C. B., Dec 22—The American fishing schooner, John Hays Hammond, Captain Gibr, arrived in port Sunday morning to find an injured seaman who miraculously escaped a watery grave a short time before daylight last Wednesday morning. The schooner while here was boarded by a heavy sea which caught one of the seamen, Hilton Acker, throwing him against the lee rail, dislocating his shoulder and washing him overboard. He managed, however, to get hold of a rope and, after calling for help, he was caught up by another sea and thrown back on deck again just as the Captain came from below. The Captain says that considering the enormous sea that was running, and Acker's condition, his escape was indeed miraculous. Mr Acker was landed here today to undergo medical treatment, and will be sent to his home in Gloucester, Mass.

TORONTO, Ont., Dec 22—The Canadian Manufacturers' Association fears a labor famine next year. Of 436 manufacturers who have answered the association's recent query 156 want more help. These 156 manufacturers say they require 5,962 employees, 2,254 male and 3,708 female. Of 156 employers that need labor one is in British Columbia, four in Manitoba, two in New Brunswick, three in Nova Scotia, thirty in Quebec and one hundred and sixteen in Ontario. Of employees needed one hundred and fifty are wanted in British Columbia, forty three in Manitoba, twenty in New Brunswick thirty-two in Nova Scotia, 2,216 in Quebec and 3,502 in Ontario.

NEW YORK, N. Y., Dec 22—Closer commercial and intellectual relations between the United States and the German empire were urged tonight by Count von Bernstorff, the imperial ambassador, who spoke before a gathering of students of the college of the City of New York, met to do him honor.

Gustav H. Schwab, manager of the North German-Lloyd S. S. Company, contrasted what he called "our haphazard log-rolling methods" of framing a tariff law with German thoroughness. A process of minute examination and sifting which extended over five years was thought necessary, before the German tariff committee presented to the parliament the first draft of a tariff bill.

HAMMONDSPORT, N. Y., Dec 22—The affairs of the Herring-Curtiss company, manufacturers of aeroplanes, are in a legal tangle. After a meeting of the board of directors of the company on Saturday, proceedings were begun in the state supreme court to compel Augustus Herring of New York, vice-president of the company, to turn over to the company in consideration of stock issued to him. An injunction was obtained to prevent Herring from disposing of this stock. Herring left Hammondsport after the meeting without reaching any agreement with the board of directors. The company is capitalized at \$500,000. Glen H. Curtiss is general manager.
