AN ELECTION OF TWENTY YEARS AGO.

Many persons seem to have forgotten that twenty years ago, in March, 1891, there was an election in which reciprocity was the issue.

It was Sir John Macdonald's last campaign. He died three months after the polling. It was Sir Wilfrid Laurier's first campaign as leader of the Liberal party.

Bold and audacious as was the policy of continental free trade, it seemed during the contest that it might be adopted. The result proved otherwise.

A HISTORIC PRECEDENT.

In consenting to Premier Asquith's request for permission to create enough new Peers to pass the Veto Bill, King George is following an historic precedent, which occurred seventy-nine years ago.

The limited measure of reciprocity now bargained for is a very different proposition from the continental free trade proposed in 1891.

A noted point of contrast between the election upon unrestricted reciprocity in 1891 and the coming election upon the present trade agreement is that then the party in power stood opposed, while now the party in power is in favor of the proposed change.
