The problem assumes in official eyes even greater importance by the fact that most of the illness due to alcoholism are hereditary.

The official figures published on alcoholism show that deaths due to drunkenness are most numerous in the north of Italy, reaching as high a rate as 4.98 in the province of Vicenza and 4.25 in the province of Belluno per hundred thousand inhabitants.
