Synopsis of Canadian North-West

**HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS**

ANY even numbered section of Dominion Land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, except by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section 160 acres, more or less.

Applications for entry must be made in person by the applicant at a Dominion Land Agency or Agency for any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to be made at an Agency on certain conditions by the father or mother, son, daughter brother or sister of any intending homesteader.

The homesteader is required to perform the homestead duties under one of the following plans:

- (1) At least six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.
- (2) A homesteader may, if so desired perform the required residence duties by living on farming land owned solely by him, not less than eighty (80) acres in extent, in the vicinity of his homestead. Joint ownership in land will not meet this requirement.
- (3) If the father or mother, if the father deceased of homesteader has permanent residence on farming land owned solely by him not less than eighty (80) acres in extent, in the vicinity of the homestead, or upon a homestead entered for by him in the vicinity such homesteader may perform his own residence duties by living with the father or mother.
- (4) The term "vicinity" in the two preceding paragraphs is defined as meaning not more than nine miles in a direct line, exclusive of the width of road allowance crossed in the measurement.
- (5) A homesteader intending to perform his residence duties in accordance with the above while living with parents and or on farming land owned by himself must notify the Agent for the district of such intention.
- (6) Six months notice in writing should be given to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa, or to the Agent for the district, not more than nine miles in a direct line, exclusive of the width of road allowance crossed in the measurement.
- (7) A homesteader intending to perform his residence duties in accordance with the above while living with himself must notify the Agent for the district of such intention.
- (8) Six months notice in writing should be given to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa, or to the Agent for the district, not more than nine miles in a direct line, exclusive of the width of road allowance crossed in the measurement.
