CLEVELAND, Aug. 16.—Louis Vain, 21, of Newark, N. J. and James Ray, 21, mechanic and aviator at the Medina Aviation Club were killed near Medina Ohio late today when their airplane went into a tail spin and fell about 200 feet.

Ray was a native of England. He came to Medina about a year ago. His body horribly mutilated was found under the tangled wreckage of the aeroplane.

Vain jumped when the machine neared the earth. He was unconscious when found and died while being taken to a hospital.
