NEW YORK, Oct. 2 (AP)—After a week of the most violent rate fluctuations in recent years, foreign exchange markets settled back to comparatively normal weekend dealings Saturday.

Sterling, on the heels of a three-day rally which carried it about 20 cents above the war-crisis lows earlier in the week, declined 1-4 cents to 44.82 in terms of the United States dollar.

The recession in the British unit affected the French franc, which dipped 0.1-2 of a cent to 2.69 3-8. The Canadian dollar closed unchanged at a discount of 9-16.
