NO DIVORCE FOR CAPTAIN SPAIN

OTTAWA, June 8.—The Senate today, by a vote of sixteen to six, adopted the report of the divorce committee, refusing a decree to Commander Spain.

Chairman Kirchoffer, of the committee stated that the recommendation or refusal was in consequence of a decision that collusion had been established. There had been agreement that the wife would submit improper relations and not resist divorce proceedings.

MacDonald, of British Columbia, believed collusion was disproved by the fact that Mrs. Spain had in fact resisted proceedings. Senator Power took the same ground and said Captain Spain was not shown to be a party to the agreement.

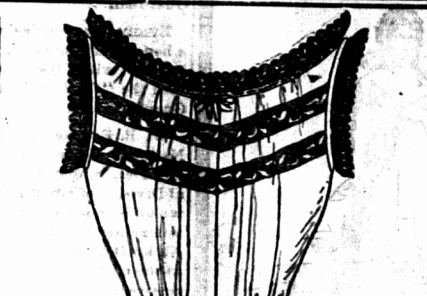

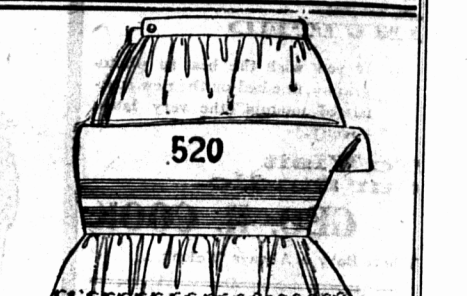
