APPLE SAUCE: Wash and cut up apples into then add golden syrup or corn lights. For every quart add 1 1-2 syrup to sweeten. Cook a few minutes water and a pinch of salt. Use longer. Flavour with nutmeg. Cover and cook gently till apples cinnamon or lemon juice.

ATTENTION FARMERS: The following regulations have been enacted by the Wartime Prices and Trade Board governing the sale of Farm Machinery:— "The minimum cash payment required on time sales is now 40% of purchase price. Where any trade-in is taken by dealer the allowance for same is to be first deducted from the purchase price and the cash payment computed as 40% of the balance. Full settlement must be made by purchaser on or before time of delivery, either in cash or at least 40% cash and signed notes for balance. No machine can be delivered without being settled for. Purchasers are required to take delivery at dealer's place of business or their own railway station, or pay an additional charge for direct delivery. Machines cannot be delivered and left on trial. Settlement must, in all cases, be made on or before delivery." Customers are fully protected against defective machines by warranty given on purchaser's order form.
