DATE SQUARES

1 1/4 cups flour 1 1/4 cups rolled oats 1/2 cup bran 1 teaspoon soda 1 teaspoon salt 1 cup brown sugar 1/2 cup butter

Method: Sift the flour, soda and salt together and mix with the rolled oats and brown sugar.

FILLING 1 lb. dates 1 1/2 cups cold water 1/2 cup seeded raisins

Method: Stone the dates and place in a saucepan with the water and raisins and cook until the water is almost all absorbed.

NEW YORK—According to the American Social Hygiene Association, which on February 4th will celebrate its Sixth Social Hygiene Day, recent studies of 218,000 in the district workers in United States show an average of 2.98 per cent are syphilitic.

Veneral Disease is still at the top of the list of "Army sick" cases. Almost three times as many days are lost from syphilis and gonorrhoea as from any other cause, according to the Association.

Veneral Disease is also now the chief cause of physical disability for military service, 5,000 cases of claim. More than twice as many days are lost from veneral diseases as from any other single cause.

During the first world war the United States forces had less veneral disease than any other engaged in the war, but military records show that there were 157,146 more new cases of syphilis and gonorrhoea among U.S. soldiers and sailors and marines than during the first world war.

During a two month period when 12,275 men were examined for military service, 5,000 cases of veneral disease were revealed, the Association discloses.
