HENRY FORD APOLOGIZES TO JEWISH PEOPLE

Withdraws Everything Said in Disparagement.

NEW YORK, July 9. — Through Arthur Brisbane, a statement was made public today quoting Henry Ford as saying he has ordered his Dearborn Independent to discontinue permanently all articles hostile to the Jewish people and expressing "great regret" over any injury the articles may have caused.

"In the multitude of my activities it has been impossible for me to devote personal attention to either to their contents. It has therefore inevitably followed that the conduct management or to keep informed as to policies of these publications had to be delegated to men whom I placed in charge of them and upon whom I relied implicitly.

FREE STATE MINISTER ASSASSINATED IN DUBLIN

One of the worst tragedies in Ireland's history occurred yesterday when Kevin O'Higgins, Minister of Justice in the Free State Cabinet, was shot by a group of men in a motor car, dying a few hours later from the wounds inflicted.

(Canadian Press) DUBLIN, July 10. — Kevin O'Higgins, Minister of Justice in the Free State Cabinet, was assassinated today near his home at Black Rock, a suburb. The assassin escaped in the confusion and has not been traced. Up to the present nothing is known of the motive for the murder or whether it was a case of political or private revenge.

O'Higgins was regarded as the "strong man" of the Government. During the recent election campaign he toured the country, speaking in nearly every county in favour of the Government candidates. Kevin O'Higgins was a nephew by marriage of Governor General Timothy Healy. He began his career as an articled clerk to Maurice Higgins, Minister of Justice in the Free State Cabinet, in 1919. He was arrested and held in Belfast prison. Upon his release he was appointed by Eamon De Valera, the Republican leader, as assistant to William T. Cosgrave, in the local government board set up by the Sinn Feiners. But he supported the treaty of Dec. 1921, and was made Minister of Justice in 1922. Later in the same year, his father was shot dead in Queen's County.

Radicals Refuse to Cooperate With Moderate Govt.

(Special to the Guardian) HANKOW, July 9. — The Hankow regime, which represents the radical wing of the nationalist movement, today announced its refusal to cooperate with the moderate nationalist government at Nanking or to break with Michael Borodin, its Russian adviser, as demanded recently by Feng Yu Siang, the former commander in chief of the Hankow forces.

Canada's Population Now 9,519,000

(Special to the Guardian) OTTAWA, Ont., July 9. — The population of Canada is now around 9,519,000 in the estimation of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics. The three prairie provinces, which have a census every five years, because of the subsidies paid to them, show fairly substantial increases in 1926, when the last census was taken and are still advancing. The population for the dominion, according to the 1921 census was 8,788,468, the increase in the six years thus being 830,517.
