MONCTON, July 12.—A terrible fatality occurred on Lower Robinson street Saturday evening by which Maggie Gaudet, aged five years, had her life crushed out. The little child was playing on the side of the street when a heavy truck team was driven along and the hind wheel of the truck passed directly over her head, crushing it badly and causing blood to gush from the nose, ears and mouth. Death was almost instantaneous.
