Broadcasts About Human Relations

"In Search Of Ourselves", dramatic radio broadcasts about human beings and their relationship with one another, began its third annual series last night and will be heard every Tuesday night at 9 P.M. over CFXY until April 4. These broadcasts will consist of a twenty minute drama about an individual with a personality difficulty, taken from a case history of a real person in Canada. Then a psychiatrist will analyze the behaviour patterns of the people whose cases are dramatized.

Last year this series, presented by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation, won honorable mention at the first "Canadian Radio Awards" presentation, 1949, "in recognition of the excellence of its aim, its form and content and the quality of its performance." Thousands of Canadians formed themselves into groups last season to listen to and discuss these broadcasts. Some of these groups had only four or five members, others were just a family group, while in some cases fifteen or twenty people met together to listen to the broadcast and discuss the topic. Any person or organization wishing to form and lead a "Listening Group" in this Province may obtain a study bulletin free of charge from Miss Mona Wilson, Director Public Health Nursing Division, Department of Health and Welfare, 188 Prince St., Charlottetown.
