For Giants
There is an old story of a sailor who, seeing for the first time a bass viol, expressed a strong desire to behold "the fellow who could put that fiddle under his chin." The recent discovery in Madagascar of an egg sixteen inches long and thirty pounds in weight led to a similar anxiety on the part of the discoverers to find the bird which was capable of laying it. The monster egg was acquired by a German scientist, who recognized it as the egg of the aepyornis, a bird of the astounding height of sixteen feet, and supposed to be extinct. That there may be specimens still living was judged by the fact that the egg was fairly fresh. Indeed, some of the scientific enthusiasts on the island actually held a banquet at which a portion of the egg was served up in the form of an omelette! (The whole egg, by the way, would have made ninety-five omelettes of ordinary size.)
As a result of the discovery a German scientific expedition has been fitted out to explore the interior of Madagascar in search of a living aepyornis. If it is found and captured there will be an exciting time, not only for the hunters, but for naturalists throughout the world. It is the largest bird that ever existed.
