Cattle were practically common cows and bulls. Common cows were 8.25—9.25, canners and cutters 6—8 and common bulls ranged from 8—10.50.  
Calves were in good demand. Good quality veals were mostly 23 with medium kinds selling between 21—22.50 and common thin light veals as low as 18. Grassers ranged from 10—12.50 according to quality.  
The few lambs offered sold on a flat basis at 15—16 and sheep (three) 3—3.50.  
The most common price paid for grade A hogs was 28.50 and sows mostly 19 pressed.

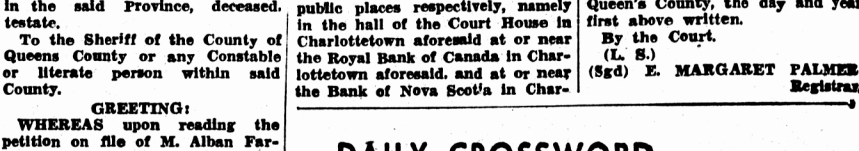
