A large number of people throughout this province will be glad to learn that the Prince Edward Island Railway will issue return tickets at single first class fare from all stations to Charlottetown on Nov. sixteenth and seventeenth good to return up to and including the eighteenth inst. to enable many to attend the King's Business Evangelistic Mission service, now being conducted in the city, under the leadership of Dr Elliott and Mr Natzger.

Another of those interesting events which are taking place from time to time, occurred Wednesday evening, Nov 10th, at the home of Russell and Mrs Burgoyne, Found's Mills, when their eldest daughter, Lilla Gertrude, was united in marriage to Lemuel Wood of the same place. The ceremony was performed by Rev H. Pierce, B. A. and was witnessed by a large number of friends of the contracting parties. The bride was attended by her sister Susie and the groom by his brother Lefuta Wood.

A sad drowning accident occurred on Thursday evening about ten o'clock off Ponds Point, between Point Prim and Flat River, the victim being Alexander Compton, the well known contractor and bridge builder of Bell River. Mr Compton, in company with John Finlay Macdonald and Charles McEachern, was sailing from Vernon River Bridge where he had completed the wharf this season, to Flat River. They were in a gasoline launch which was towing a scow. While walking along the deck Mr Compton stumbled and fell overboard. The night was dark, and no trace of him could be seen afterwards, although Macdonald and McEachern searched for some time. There was only three and a half feet of water where he went overboard, but the strong current had carried the body some distance away. He was about seventy years of age and had constructed a number of public works, in Queen's County. Among the surviving members of his family is a son Wellington, who had been associated with him in his contracts of recent years, and a daughter Mrs Larkin, wife of the Captain of the dredge Prince Edward.
