THE POSITION OF RUSSIAN JEWS

BERLIN, March 15.—The position of Hebrews in Russia is horrible. Massacres exceeding those that occurred in the past may be renewed at any hour. He says he found indisputable evidence that the October massacres were organized. They occurred in 400 cities and towns simultaneously, and were identical in character. In every case the Jewish quarters were raided and plundered, and women and children outraged by armed roughs, while the police looked on. When the Jews forcibly resisted they were shot by the soldiers as Hottentots. Dr. Nathan procured at Odessa a copy of a circular issued to the garrison last week, urging the soldiers to rise and crush the traitors who were plotting to overthrow the government and secure a Jewish regime. The circular was printed at the office of the Imperial general staff, and was passed by the censor.

PROPOSED CANAL AT GEORGIAN BAY

MONTREAL, March 15.—What it will cost to construct the Georgian Bay Canal will not be known until next year. The survey will not be completed until then. The engineers are hopeful, however, that the cost will be within the hundred million mark, which has been the popular estimate of the cost of the waterways. The most difficult problem which is presenting itself to the engineers, is how to hold the water at the height of land divided at Lake Talon, between Lake Nipissing and Mattawa. There are two feasible routes for this part of the Canal and both of them are being thoroughly surveyed. One of the suggestions for maintaining the water supply at the height of land, is a tunnel to a chain of lakes five miles distant, and about seventy feet above the proposed Canal.
