**Scrap Iron Prices Decline In U. S.**

CLEVELAND, Aug. 17—(AP)—Scrap prices have taken a "downward" but heavy demands by United States steelmakers for raw material indicate that the scrap iron market still is in a "bullish" position, the magazine steel reported today.

"Unquestionably, the 'zing' has gone out of the current market," said the magazine, "but it still is in a basically bullish position with supplies none too plentiful and consumption at an unprecedented rate for peacetime."

Prices of scrap declined \$2 to \$3.50 per ton at virtually all important consuming points last week, said the journal.

The price decline has been accompanied by an easier flow of material, said Steel, with some large buyers who had been out of the market placing substantial orders.

Pig iron is in a "very tight" market, however, and scrap stocks have not increased materially during the summer months and face difficulties of fall and winter collections in the near future, the magazine reported.

The steel ingot rate in the United States dropped one point last week to 94 per cent of capacity.

**Crop Report**  
WINNEPEG, Man., Aug. 15 — Cooler weather with varying amounts of rain have been received over most of the prairies during the past week. The rain the late sown crops and in southern Manitoba it will delay harvesting and possibly reduce the grade of an otherwise good crop. Harvesting operations in the southern parts of all three Provinces have been delayed but with dry weather will be well under way by the beginning of the week. Prospects remain good in Manitoba, in eastern Saskatchewan and in the area north and west of Edmonton, but elsewhere have shown no improvement during the past week. Scattered local hail damage is reported but the areas concerned are mostly small and of little consequence to the overall picture. Labor and machinery supplies are adequate at most points, according to the weekly crop report of the Department of Agriculture of the Canadian National Railways.
