The Varuna, with Eugene Higgins, her owner, and several guests on board, was impaled on a rock off the west point of the island of Madiera at two o'clock on the morning of Tuesday, November 16. The party de-



parted from New York on November 2 and arrived at Hamilton, Bermuda, on November 5. The voyage was re-

sumed two days later, it being the intention to stop at Madiera on the way to Gibraltar and the Mediterranean. When the yacht struck, all on board took to the small boats. Mr Higgins and his party made a landing at Point Delgado on Wednesday evening. Other boats with part of the crew landed at part Nuniz and Vincente, villages on the north coast of Madiera, and one boat was rescued by a passing steamer and its occupants brought to Funchal. Only one life was lost, that of Charles Bird, officer's Cook, who was drowned. The Varuna proved a total loss, nothing on board being saved.
