## Reduced Hours Of Labor At Increased Wages Is Advocated At Convention

(C.P. By Guardian's Special Wire) TRURO, N.S., Nov. 21—Reduced hours of labor at increased wages were advocated as a solution of the unemployment problem today by R. J. Tallon, of Montreal, vice president of the Canadian Trades and Labor Congress, in an address before the district 26 convention of the United Mine Workers of America.

This was the only way, he said, to insure a living wage for all workers. "There are not enough jobs to go around now," he asserted. "There are sons of miners old enough to work who have no work; society cannot absorb the men who are graduating from our schools."

### Possible Solution

"The only possible solution to the whole situation," he told his audience of miners' representatives, "is to reduce the hours of labor to the degree that will absorb all workers and to raise the rates so that the workers can buy what they need. "And if that can't be done, it will be just too bad. Primarily, the people have to live."

### Internal Dispute

In Alberta, he said, the miners

had not been able to get the best out of the coal industry because internal disputes among themselves had left the industry in "chaos." Dual organization had exercised bad effects among Canada's railway workers.

Urging the miners to remain loyal to the U. M. W., he told them there was no foundation for criticism on the ground of American domination. In any event, he said, present conditions were "better than dictation from Russia."

### Makes Charge

(Yesterday District President D. W. Morrison declared before the convention that the Amalgamated Mine Workers—the U. M. W.'s rival union in the Nova Scotia coal fields—"received its direction from the headquarters of the Communist party in Toronto.")

Touching further upon Russia, he declared a "wonderful experiment" was underway in that "misinterpreted" country and that soon she would be meeting the world on an equal footing.

"Revolutions," he said, "are born in capitalistic systems when capitalistic systems fail." In Canada, things were "coming about overnight." Many people were "becoming impatient, and should be. A great revolution, like the mills of the gods, is going on."

## AUSTRIA CLAIMS ARMS EQUALITY

### Disarmament Committee Will Attempt to Curb Secret Arming.

(A. P. By Guardian's Special Wire) GENEVA, Nov. 20—A broad plan designed to halt secret arming of nations and prevent international terrorism will be brought before committees of the disarmament conference in January.

The proposal to turn the white light of publicity on the arms traffic was put before today's meeting of the disarmament conference by Hugh R. Wilson, United States minister to Switzerland. Before the session adjourned, Arthur Henderson, President of the disarmament conference, was authorized to convene committees to consider the plan. Austria took advantage of the meeting of the conference steering committee to announce her claim to equality of armaments, something denied her by Great War peace treaties, stating that the country had been "deprived of all security in the face of growing armaments."

The quotation comes from Mrs. Roscoe Turner, wife of the flying Colonel who finished third in the London-Melbourne air race. She was back home from London.

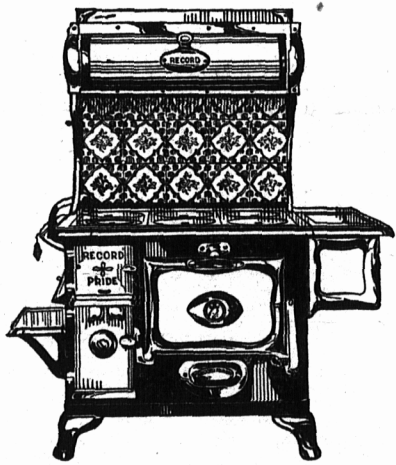
LAW IS ON SIDE OF MARY AND HER LAMB PHILADELPHIA, Nov. 21—If Mary had had a lawyer, her little
