QUEBEC May 1.—Monday afternoon the heavy pressure of water on the new dam of the Chicoutimi Paper and Pulp Company broke away the earth approaches and flooded the lower dam. The result of such an unexpected overflow of water caused considerable damage to the new portion of the mill. Although the amount of the damage could not be exactly estimated this morning it is believed it will reach \$25,000 or \$30,000.

### TO INCLUDE CANADA.

LONDON May 1.—At a meeting of the British empire league today it was disclosed that the colonial office has been in correspondence with the government of Canada in regard to including Canada in the title of King Edward.

### MILITARY CHANGES.

Sir Archibald Hunter to go to Scotland.

LONDON, April 30.—General Sir Archibald Hunter has been appointed to the command of the forces in Scotland, and General Ian Hamilton has been appointed military secretary to the War Office.

Major-Gen. Sir Archibald Hunter, so well known as Gen. White's chief of staff at Ladysmith, and latterly, general commanding the tenth division in South Africa, was born Sept. 6, 1853. He was educated at Glasgow Academy, and at Sandhurst Military College. He joined the 4th Foot, now the King's Own Royal Lancaster Regiment, in 1874, becoming captain in 1882, Lieut.-Col. in 1889, colonel in 1894, and major-general in 1896. He served in Egypt under Sir Francis Grenfell and was severely wounded at Gennis in 1885 and slightly at Tashk in 1896. He was governor of Dongola province and commandant of the Frontier Field Force 1895-99, and Governor of Omdurman in 1899.

Major-General Ian S. M. Hamilton, C. B. D. S. O., was born at Corfu, Jan. 16, 1853 being the eldest son of Col. Christian M. Hamilton. He was educated at Cheam and Wellington Colleges, entering the army in 1873. He first saw active service in the Afghan war, 1878-80, being twice mentioned in despatches. He afterwards took part in the Boer war of 1881, and was again mentioned in despatches. He also served in the Nile expedition of 1884-85 receiving his brevet of major, and in the Burmese expedition of 1883-87 and was with the Chitral relief force in 1895. He became lieutenant-colonel in 1887, and colonel in 1891. After Chitral he was commandant of the Hythe School of Musketry until the year 1899, when he went to the front on the breaking out of the war with the Transvaal. Since 1900 he served as major-general on the staff of the Natal Field Force, and has done good service in rounding up the Boers still in the field.

### SAW HER OWN HEART BEAT.

CHICAGO, April 29.—A singular thing happened in this city yesterday. Miss Dora B. Peters saw her own heart beat. She was afflicted with sinking attacks and felt sure that at such times her heart ceased to beat. She visited her physician, who saw that her heart acted regularly. The difficulty was to convince the girl. Finally an X ray tube was adjusted, darkened by a cloth, behind her back. The fluoroscope was placed over her heart, and a heavy blanket thrown over her head to shut out the light. The girl then held a mirror directly in front of her heart.
