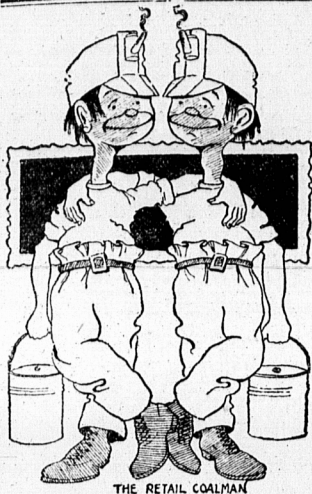

PRACTICAL LESS-ONS AS TO THE BENEFITS OF RECIPROCITY. WOODSTOCK, N. B., March 1—Those who voted for reciprocity, and those who voted against it, will be interested in the fact that a train load of hay left Woodstock today, on its way to Norfolk, Virginia, in spite of the heavy freight and the duty of four dollars a ton.

The sale of hay was made by Phillips Esley & Co., and consisted of 190 tons, filling eighteen cars. The freight and duty amounted to \$12 a ton and the duty alone was \$792.
