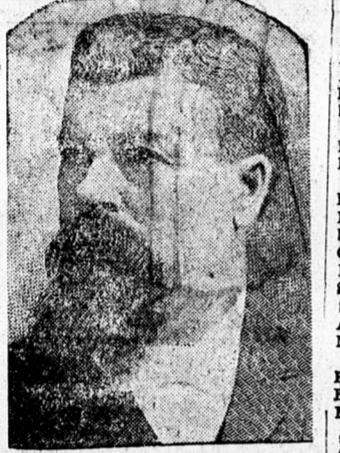

HORSE NOTE.

One of the largest owners of horses in America was asked recently what he thought of the practice of clipping, and in reply he spoke something to this effect:

"I would as soon think of going through life from year to year without my own bath as to think of permitting our horses to go unclipped from year to year. Our men have demonstrated time and again to our satisfaction that we have not a horse about the place that is not worth clipping at the proper time. Every horse should be clipped at least once a year, and if proper care is given, two clippings, one in the spring and one in the fall, are advisable. When horses are clipped in the fall they should be protected by a blanket or other covering if allowed to stand in the open air any length of time especially if they have been doing work. Clipping seems to put more life into the horse, as it relieves him of the extra coat and readily permits the cleaning brush to do its work properly, so that the pores are open and free at all times to rid the animal of waste matter, for which the natural outlet is through the skin pores.

From the above it would seem worth while for every owner of horses who does not now clip to look into the matter. The practice of clipping has certainly been increasing very fast in this country, and it is said that farmers and horse owners in European countries have long been following it very generally.


