Bethlehem Steel Dividends Up

NEW YORK, July 25 (AP)—Bethlehem Steel Corp. reported today second quarter net income of \$10,807,318, or \$3.07 a share on the common stock. This compares with \$3,822,927, or 61 cents a common share in the June, 1939 quarter, and \$10,891,139, or \$3.02 a common share, in the March quarter this year. Directors ordered a dividend of \$1.25 on the common stock. A similar payment was made in June and \$1 was paid in January. The latest dividend is payable Sept. 3 to holders of record Aug. 9.

By Frederek Gardner Associated Press Financial Writer NEW YORK, July 25 (AP)—Traders continued to look askance at the stock market today although a few stepped in at the last and gave a lift to selected steels, motors and specialties. Prominent questions were: Will England be able to withstand an apparent Nazi delay in a broad assault indicate peace talks may be in the offing? How much will the home tax bill total? When will a definite presidential campaign trend make its appearance? What Canadian issues were unchanged to fractions lower. Distillers-Seagrams, Ford and Imperial Oil were the losers while International Nickel and Hollinger gained fractions. In the bond market, Canada 4s were unchanged. The Associated Press average of 90 stocks was up .1 of a point at 41.3 against a decline of 2 in the preceding session. Activity picked up slightly now and then and transfers amounted to 244,800 shares compared with yesterday's 22-year low volume of 193,200. Bethlehem Steel ran up a point in the final hour and U. S. Steel gained 7-8. Chrysler jumped 2 1-8. General Motors was 1-8 ahead, N. Y. Central, Pennsylvania and Santa Fe were a shade improved. Among gainers of fractions were Anaconda, Glenn Martin, Loft, Du Pont, General Electric, U. S. Rubber and Sears Roebuck. Fractionally lower were American Telephone, Great Northern, Westinghouse, American Can, Youngstown Sheet and International Harvester. 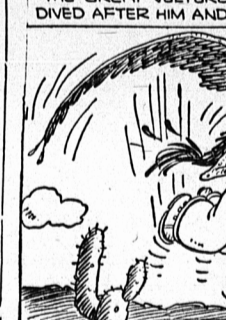
Foothill 40. TORONTO, July 25 (CP)—The stock market put on a moderate trading spurt in the final half-hour today, giving the golds an index gain of 1.13 and the industrials a gain of .43. Other groups finished the day unchanged. Turnover was 100,000 shares. Central Patricia advanced 10 cents, Kerr-Addison had the same gain, and Preston firmed 4 cents. The price was up 2 to 5 cents for Broulan, Cariboo, East Malartic, Macassa, McKenzie and Sheep Creek, Sylvanite firmed 10 cents and Toburn 25. National Steel Car, down a point, was the weakest of the heavy industrials. Sizeable losses were netted by United Fuels A, Page-Reger and Photo Engravers. Distillers-Seagrams gained 1-2 and Canadian Breweries Common was 10 cents up. The preferred also firmed moderately. Other strong industrials were Consumers Gas, Fanny Farmer, Westons and Montreal Power. Sleep Rock tightened up 12 cents, Home Oil gained 2 cents, and Commell, Davies and Calgary-Edmonton were slightly lower. Royalite lost 1-2 point. 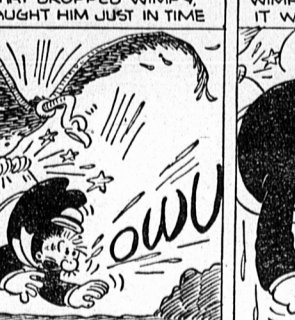

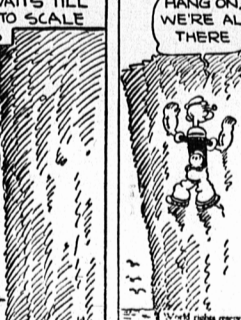
