A party order on the 10th anniversary of the formation of the first Fascist combat squad cited the profound pride of the Italian people in the valor of the Italian Legionnaires, "who once more are an essential factor in victory on Spanish soil."

Boothby, Conservative, in a debate on unemployment in the House of Commons today.

Chamberlain To Make Statement In House Today Will Likely Avoid Pledges To Czechoslovakia—Speed-up Arms Program.

LONDON, March 23—(CP)—Prime Minister Chamberlain tonight asked organized labor support to speed up rearmament before disclosing to the House of Commons tomorrow Great Britain's position in an uneasy Europe. There were indications the Prime Minister and the cabinet had decided upon a declaration of policy which would include no promise of military support of Czechoslovakia. It was believed Mr. Chamberlain would declare, however, that Britain cannot disassociate herself from events in central Europe and would stress that any aggression against that country, now largely surrounded by an enlarged Germany, might well start a general European conflagration.

Blum Regime At Grips With Senate

Contentious Fiscal Legislation May Lead To Crisis. PARIS, March 23—Premier Leon Blum's Popular Front government came to grips with the Senate today for the first time today in the passage of his cabinet's proposed budget. The measure provides for a 10 per cent increase in the tax on the profits of companies and a 10 per cent increase in the tax on the profits of individuals.

Reassuring Reply

It said he sought "moderation and mildness to diminish to the greatest extent possible the horrors of war." 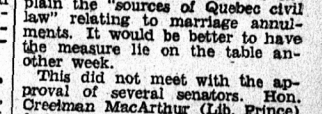
