The Schooner Eva May, Capt Reynolds, cleared from Charlottetown yesterday for Sydney with produce. This is the first schooner to clear this port this year.

Daniel Cronin, Charlottetown, who was recently sentenced to six months' imprisonment for a third offence against the prohibition act, is supposed to have crossed to the mainland yesterday, bound to parts unknown.

The St. John Times Star, editorially says:—Prince Edward Island at intervals provides a tragic sensation quite out of the ordinary. This affair of the mysterious death of the six children of the McGee family appears to present some extraordinary features.

At a meeting held in Cruickshank & McPhee's store, last Friday night A. G. Campbell presiding, a Board of Trade was formed with the following gentlemen as officers: Pres., A. G. Beach; Vice Pres., Maynard McPhee; Sec-Treas., S. J. Morrison; Executive, A. J. Mason, A. G. Campbell and S. W. Dawson. At their first meeting (Mon. night) the Board decided to petition for cars to get the grain out. There is already a membership of some 20 or 30 members.—Earl Grey, Sask., exc. (Mr. McPhee, referred to above, was formerly a resident of North River.)

As a result of the recent Equitation classes held in Charlottetown the following members of the Fourth Regiment Heavy Brigade have duly qualified: Captains D. A. McKinnon, C. Leonard McKay, Lieutenants J. A. S. Bayer, J. Webb Stanley, Hammond L. Bellune, George W. McLeod, William A. McEldner, Sergeants A. McCabe and G. Elmer Ritchie. All of the above passed the necessary examination and received their certificates. The equitation classes were held by Major Hayer, Halifax, D. A. G. of the Sixth Division, and Captain Walker Bell, Canadian Dragoons, Toronto, who also conducted the examinations.

The following market prices from a Fredericton exchange show quite a comparison with those prevailing in Charlottetown and will be read with interest here.—Potatoes, per bushel \$3 mark in the country market this morning, and a number of sales at \$3.25 took place while several sales as high as \$3.50 per barrel were also said to have taken place. Butter was very scarce and sold at 33 and 34 cents per pound, with some sales at 35 and others—large orders—as low as 30 and 32. Veal sold at from 6 to 10 cents per pound by the quarter; beef sold at 75 cents per half barrel and live young pigs brought \$2.75 each.

Last week a fellow countryman of the condemned murderer, Tony Garrio, who will suffer the death penalty in Sydney during the first week of May for the murder of a P. E. Island man, Lewis McLaren, was subscribing names for a petition to be forwarded to the Minister of Justice praying for a commutation of the death sentence. A very few English-speaking people seemed to favor executive clemency, judging by the names on the petition, and in the case of the names signed, it will not be difficult for the Minister to notice that the handwriting in many cases is one and the same, although different names are signed. Garrio's execution is set for May 2nd.—North Sydney Herald.

During the past few days a good deal of interest has been attracted by two pictures in the window of the Maritime Stationers, Ltd., Charlottetown. These are the work of J.A.S. Bayer, Photographer, and he has pictured plainly the difference which could be made in the appearance of Government Pond. For the purpose of comparison there is one enlarged photo showing its actual appearance and, another upon which Mr. Bayer had bestowed a little attention with the brush, portrays the improvement which could be effected with a little effort on the part of citizens and civic authorities. Mr. Bayer has done his work well, and the suggestions in the second photo are plainly set out and the enormous change, by which the Pond could be transformed from its present appearance to a beauty spot, is made apparent.

A. E. Morrison, of the Anglo-American Telegraph Co., Charlottetown, left yesterday afternoon for Cape Traverse where he will look after the repairs to the broken cable. The tug William Aitken, Capt. Batt, leaves this morning and it is expected, if conditions are favorable, to have the service working again as usual on Friday night.

Bruce Stewart & Co., Ltd. Charlottetown, have ready for shipment a magnificent four cycle two cylinder Imperial Marine Motor which was ordered by Dr. John B. Gilchrist, Greenwich, N. B., some time ago. This engine will be placed in a particularly fast model motor boat, constructed after the style of the "Firt," and its twenty horse power is expected to develop a speed of twenty miles an hour.

An evidence of the rapid development of the fur raising industry in this province was to be seen one afternoon at the P. E. I. R. Station at Charlottetown recently. Lined up on the Express Company's truck were eleven boxes containing little fur bearing animals, foxes, mink, racoons and even a distinctly new variety of rabbits being among the collection. Some of the importations came from the middle States and Maine and they were consigned to many different parts of the Province. The animals attracted a great deal of attention as they were being transferred to the different trains.
