Faculty of Theology, Laval University, Quebec, P. Q., Nov. 29th, 1917. Mr. and Mrs. G. D. McLeod, Hunter River, P. E. Island.

Very dear friends:—I have just received a letter from mother announcing the very sad news of the death of your beloved son, Elmer, my own cherished friend and playmate from childhood; and the sorrow which I experience in the loss of one I loved and esteemed so much is made still greater when I think of you, his well-beloved parents, who must in this dark hour of bereavement, support, perhaps the greatest trial of your lives.

The death of a loved one must always be a severe trial, even in the best of circumstances, when one has the consolation of assisting the dying in the last hour of earthly trouble. But when death comes far away from home and family, the shock to those who are left behind, becomes still harder to bear, even when as in Elmer's case, a noble life has been laid down for God and Country. This is why my most sincere and heartfelt sympathy goes out to you both—I can in some small measure realize the pang of grief and sorrow which must afflict your parental hearts in the death of him, who had always been a dutiful, son, a talented school boy, and an honour to your family and our native village.

Poor Elmer, my heart and mind go back to our school days when we played and studied together and I can say without exaggeration that we never had a word of disagreement. We were joined by the pure and strong ties of childhood friendship which common aims of student life made lasting and enduring. Later on I had the pleasure of being his fellow student in Prince of Wales College and everywhere he was always the same sincere friend, always pleasant, and with a cheerful word for all.

A short time after we joined the colors to give his services for King and Country, I met him as Sergeant McLeod in Charlottetown. It was just before my departure for the military and I remember distinctly the last "chat" we had together. As he was leaving me he said—perhaps hardly realizing the import of his words: "Well, Jim, old boy, perhaps I'll not see you again." I expressed the hope that he would soon be back, little realizing that that was not to be. Since taking up the study of Theology, I often thought of him and had decided to write him about a month ago. He perhaps never received my letter. But dear friends, though your trial is a hard one, there are so many comforting thoughts about the death of one who sacrifices himself for his Country's sake that I hope you will see the silver lining shining through the dark cloud which is now passing over your lives. Elmer has been one of the first to offer his services to his King and his promotion from one Corps to another and most especially the coveted honour of the Lieutenancy which was bestowed upon him, show that his life as a soldier was worthy of you, his parents, and that his last sacrifice was that of a real hero.

But we must not border our thoughts to the things of this life—we must look further on to the promised land and life everlasting. "Greater love no man hath, than he who giveth his life for his friends." This Elmer has nobly and gallantly done. So you can look forward with confidence to a brighter day when you will meet again "when the sorrows of the world will be no more, where there shall be no more mourning or weeping."

You have then, Mr. and Mrs. McLeod, my most sincere sympathy. I only hope and pray that God will give you strength and grace to bear up in this, your hour of sad affliction. Very sincerely, Your faithful friend, JAMES C. MCGUIGAN.

SUPREME COURT.—In the case of the King vs. Frank Hawkins charged with seducing a girl between the ages of 14 and 16, which was continued yesterday morning. After the evidence for the prosecution was all put in, the Court having refused to admit evidence which was tendered to show a resemblance between the child and the prisoner Donald McKinnon, K.C., Counsel for the Crown, directed a stay of proceedings as there was not sufficient corroborative evidence to allow the case to be given to the jury. H. J. Palmer, K.C., Counsel for the prosecutrix, Mary E. Berrigan acquiesced in Mr. McKinnon's direction. His Lordship, Mr. Justice Hazard consented to the stay of proceedings being entered, declaring that under the Criminal Code the evidence for the prosecutrix must be corroborated in some material particular. The case was accordingly withdrawn from the jury and the prisoner released.
