Synopsis of Canadian North-west Land Regulations.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency in the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Agency, on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.
Duties.—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land, each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a tract of at least 80 acres, if he owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may accept a quarter-section along side his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties. Must reside six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra.
A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may take a purchase homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$300.00.

EARL GREY ANSWERS CRITICISM OF SPEECHES

WINNIPEG, Oct. 17.—Criticism of Earl Grey's Calgary naval defence utterance was answered by the Governor General in a speech before the Canadian Club yesterday.
"What can I talk about?" he asked.
"I have received warnings through the press that I must abstain from uttering even a whisper on any political subject, for fear that it may be misreported. Even if I do succeed in ordering my conversation aright I am warned that ignorance of stenographer may throw me down and therefore that silence is golden. With these caveats ringing loudly in my ears what am I to do."
"For nearly five years I have endeavored, in my political utterances, to call the attention of the people of Canada to the importance of keeping before them high national and Imperial ideas. For nearly five years I have, quite conscious by my constitutional limitations, walked the tight rope of platitudinous generalities, and I am not aware of having made any serious slips. His Majesty's Canadian Government appear to be very much of the same opinion, for they have paid the usual compliment of printing, at public cost, my answers to addresses and speeches which, inasmuch as they have dealt with politics, although in no controversial manner, shows that in their opinion I have not committed any constitutional offence. I will, therefore, assume that they and you desire me to continue as I have begun."
