Pigeons Have Sleepy Sickness

NEW YORK, Dec. 9.—(AP)—
Discovery of sleeping sickness among pigeons was announced today in science by LeRoy D. Fothergill and John H. Dingle of Harvard Medical School.
The pigeon sickness is the same thing as human encephalitis, the highly fatal disease which frequently leaves minds crippled for life when it does not kill.
The disease attacks the brain, with a wide variety of results. It accounts for some of the "sleeping beauty" cases. Not all the victims are sleepy, but usually troubles with the eye accompany the attack.
Today's announcement follows by only two weeks the discovery of this same illness in ringnecked pheasants. This also was announced from Harvard Medical School.
Both the pigeons and the pheasants with the brain disease appeared in Massachusetts in an area where horses had an epidemic of sleeping sickness last August and September.
Several children caught the disease from these horses, but this was not verified until fall. It was

a revelation to the medical profession. Until then it had been believed that human and animal sleeping sickness were not interchangeable.
