## GERMAN GROWTH AMAZES EUROPE

### The Kaiser Rules an Empire Greater Than That of Napoleon

BERLIN, Sept. 21.—The Kaiser rules a stronger empire than Napoleon ever dreamed of. Germany has a population of 60,000,000. Outside the empire there are 61,000,000 people of German race in central Europe, who must gravitate toward Germany. Here are virtually 80,000,000 citizens of homogeneous nationality covering a vast territory and not divided by racial differences.

Germany has passed both England and France in population; her population is increasing faster than that of any other European state, Russia excepted; her death rate is lowest. The official German annual, which appeared this week, makes good reading for the nation.

A generation back France had the largest population of the civilized European states. Now both England and France are falling rapidly behind. The German population is growing at a rate of rather over 800,000 souls a year, the British population by only 40,000 souls yearly. In man power, which is necessarily the basis of national strength, where the population is educated intelligent and brave, Germany is outdistancing her competitors.

The population of the United Kingdom last year was 43,200,000; that of Germany 60,000,000. Between 1890 and 1905 Germany gained 11,200,000 against England's gain of 5,800,000. Yet, notwithstanding this enormous increase in the number of men for whom work had to be provided, German industry has expanded at such a rate that unemployment has positively decreased in the period. Statisticians are agreed that in 1905 there were fewer unemployed than ever in the past of Germany's history. The percentage, in fact, was only 1.6, or one third the British percentage.

The vitality of the nation is reflected in the high birth-rate—much higher than that of England and Wales. The death rate at the same time is falling more rapidly than the British death rate, so that at the end of the chain Germany is gaining ground. The net German surplus of births over deaths per thousand was 11.7 in 1890 and 14.5 in 1904; in England it was 10.7 in 1890 and only 11.7 in 1904.

In 1890 England used 151,000,000 tons of coal, Germany 80,000,000. In 1905 the figures were: England, 230,000,000; Germany, 173,000,000. These are significant figures, when it is remembered that in England more coal is used by the mercantile marine and burned in houses than in Germany. In fact, measured by coal consumption, German industry is fast overtaking British industry. In the manufacture of iron, where for a century England held the primacy, Germany has gone ahead.

For the past 15 years the dividends on the ordinary stock of British railways have been steadily declining, the fall having been from 4.8 per cent, in 1890 to 3.3, in 1904, when an allowance is made for "watered stock." In Germany the profits earned by the railways have risen from 2.2 per cent, in 1890 to 6 in 1904.

## DEATH MYSTERY IN NEW YORK

NEW YORK, Sept. 21.—At an early hour today the police had made practically no progress in unravelling the mystery surrounding the finding yesterday of portions of the body of a murdered man in a pit at West 33rd Street and 11th Avenue.

Another portion of the dismembered body was recovered by the police today. One of the missing thighs was found two blocks away at 11th avenue and 38th street. It was wrapped in burlap bag and was found in an empty rail road car in a freight yard near the place where the arms and the lower portion of the legs were found yesterday. In another bundle was a short portion of a leg below the knee. Search for the head of the missing man is being kept up.
