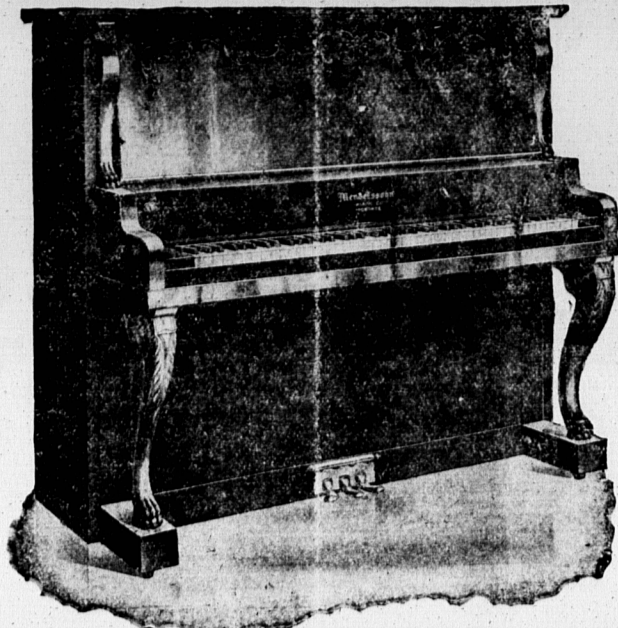

"The people that sat in darkness saw a great light."—Matt. 4:16.

POINTED SUGGESTIONS.

There is ample evidence to show that the movements of Jesus through the whole course of His gracious ministry were timed in the counsels of God. When the hour had come He passed from one place to another or from one character of service to another. The lesson opens with a suggestion of the divine strategy. The Saviour of man is never to be left without witness. If the testimony of John is closed by the infancy of Herod it is, but the clock stroke which begins the more unique and authoritative testimony of the Son of Man himself. To them which sat in the region and shadow of death, to them did light spring up.

Jesus became a tax-paying citizen of Capernaum. It was a flourishing place. It was comparatively a new city, and in the swing of material prosperity. But it failed because it knew not the day of its visitation. The privilege it had of exaltation heaven-him, because of the citizenship of Jesus with all that it brought, was forfeited for a portion not so tolerable as that of Sodom. In like manner, in a degree it be less, the folly of the city is apparent which regards not the presence nor esteems the service of its best citizens.

Why did not Jesus take up His abode in Jerusalem? Why did he make His first ministerial residence in a place without Jewish history of any age-long traditions? Why did He place Himself, at once, in contact with the Gentile world? Answers to these questions will reveal the strategical as well as the religious significance of our Lord's Messianic ministry. He brings opportunity to the warm blood of new generations, He cannot be confined to history or to places or things which are outworn. Nevertheless, Capernaum is an outstanding example of failure to secure a permanent place in history by reason of the fact that it was not equal to the grasp of a great social and moral and heaven-commissioned issue. It is cast down to hell. What about your town, when Jesus Christ asks for the verdict of righteousness at the polls?

The Master always has a closer call to definite personal allegiance and service for those who are ready to listen to His message or to be blessed by His beneficence.

When a call to service, such as Peter and Andrew and the sons of Zebedee so frankly and unhesitatingly responded to, comes to any man,

let him understand that he is to have spiritual dignity added to his chosen life-work. Every honest occupation can find its exalted counter-part in God's service. From fishermen to fishers of men is only indicative of the uplift that consecration can give to the daily vocation of anyone. Whatever is done in Christ's name and for Christ's sake is thereby glorified.

Teaching—preaching—healing. Those words portray the great powers of Jesus and the manifold nature of His service to men. He is as pastor and evangelist and physician in one. TUB TALK No. 3

To wash fine lace curtains, first brush out as much dust as possible with a soft whisk broom. Then baste each curtain carefully upon an old piece of muslin a little larger in size than the curtains, tacking each scallop firmly in place. Make a strong suds with Taylor's Borax Soap and warm water, and let the curtain soak in this for about half an hour. Then squeeze gently with the hand until clean; (do not rub) rinse, starch and spread perfectly straight on the floor or other smooth surface, fastening the muslin down firmly with small brads. 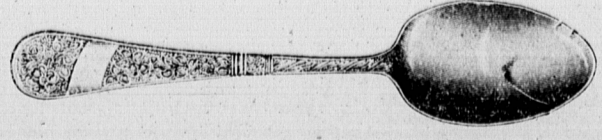
FOR BREAD AND PASTRY
