Synopsis of Canadian Northwest Land Regulations.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family, or a single man over 18 years of age, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta.

The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Agency, on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

Duties.—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section along side his homestead. Price \$10 per acre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to clear homestead, pasture and cultivate fifty acres extra.

A homesteader who has exhausted his home-stand right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$300 per acre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$500.00.
