To Reduce Foreign Secretary's Salary

 LONDON, June 21.—Former Labor Premier, Ramsay MacDonald, on behalf of the Labor opposition has put down a motion to reduce the Foreign Secretary's salary as a protest against the Security Pact deal with France.

When the big security debate probably the most important in the House of Commons since the war comes up on Wednesday, the Conservative majority will vote against what amounts to a vote of censure that would compel the Government to resign if carried.

United States Will Not Enter Pact

WASHINGTON, June 21.—That the United States under no circumstances will enter, directly or indirectly, into any European Security Pact was reiterated at the White House this afternoon. The statement was called forth by a clause in the recent German note to the British Government that Germany proposed to pledge herself to the United States as trustee.
