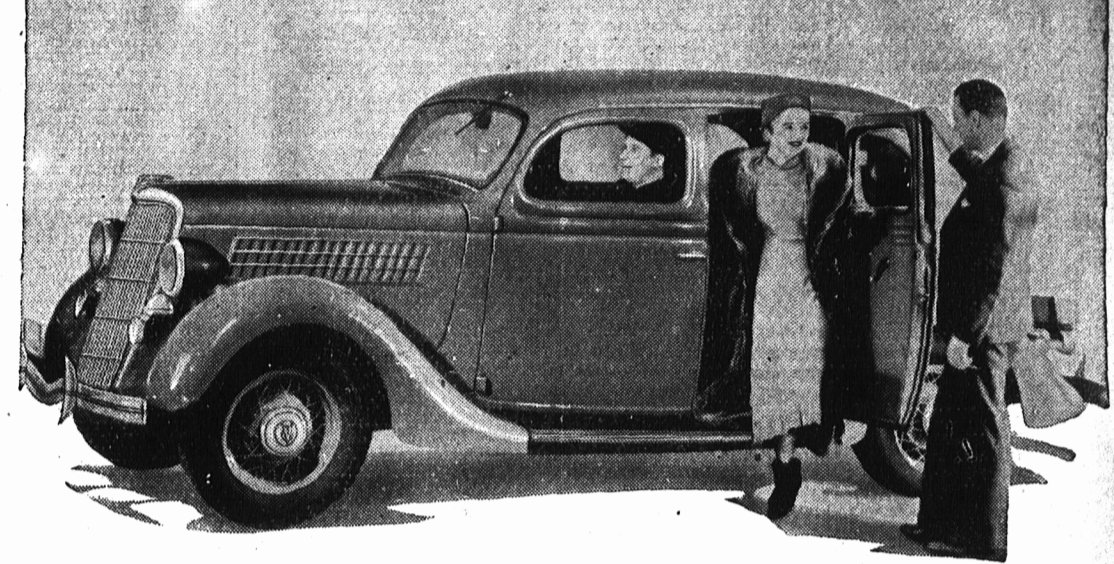

NEW YORK, N. Y., Feb. 6.—Wheat, cotton closed a trifle lower and purchased near today's lows.

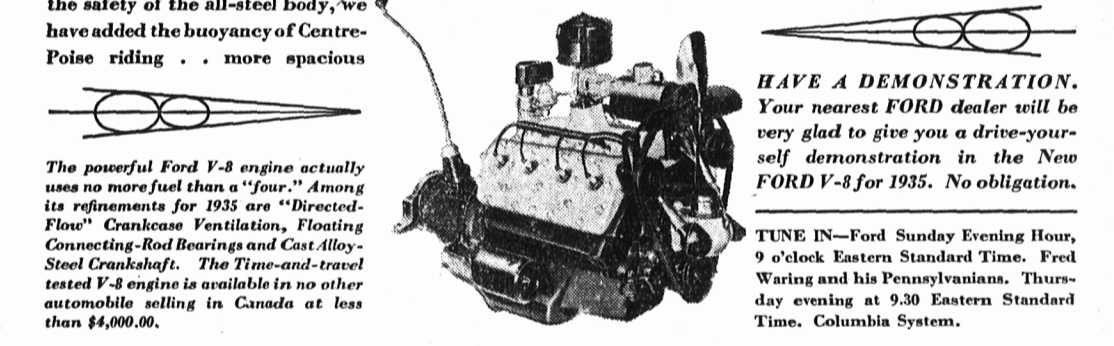
Light Trading on N.Y. Mart
