TORONTO, Nov. 6.—Toronto Stock Exchange members net borrowing on collateral as of October 30 were \$28,373,092 a decrease of \$6,853,331 from the previous month.

MONTREAL, Nov. 6.—Distillers Corp. Seagrams—For year ended July 31 net working capital over \$45,000,000. Compared with \$27,600,000 a year before—cash up \$4,000,000 account receivable up \$3,000,000 and inventories up \$14,000,000—sales for year \$81,800,000 gain of 35 per cent over preceding year.

Car Loadings—For week ended October 30—59,689 against 61,349 in previous week and 59,995 a year ago.

Copper—Leading New York customs smelter reduced price yesterday to 11 1/2 cents per pound. Export copper prices dropped from 10.55 to 10.25 cents.

Canada Wire and Cable—Declares dividend \$6.75 per share on preferred arrears, payable December 1 to record Nov. 18. Total payments this year 16.50 per share leaving arrears after December payment \$8,371-2 per share.

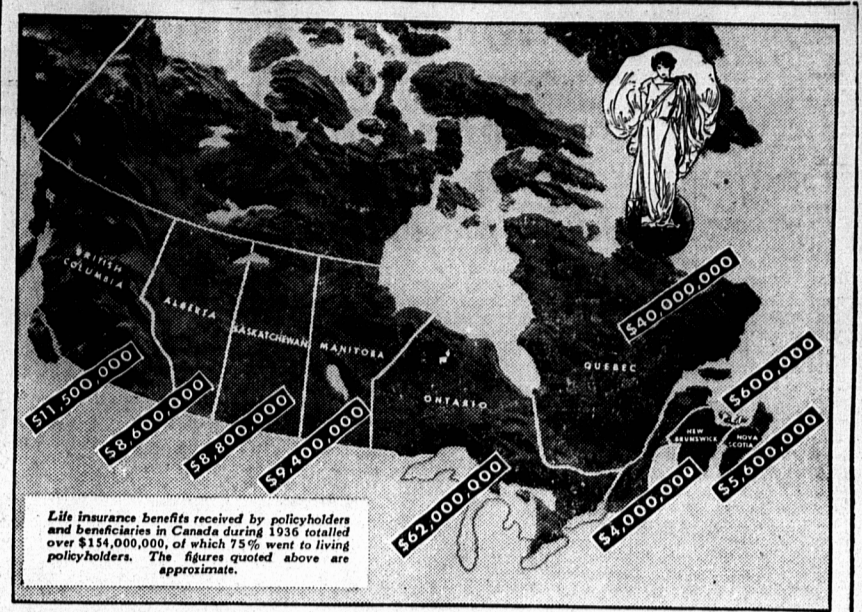
like 1936 period.
