would be disagreement, each man would have more or less his own theory. Or again: we all have some of the facts of Canadian history to study. I study them as carefully and as accurately as I can, and come out in my political philosophy a rabid Tory, while another man with equal candour, equal ability, studying the same facts, will come out a double and twisted Liberal.

The difficulties to be confronted in the greater or lesser union are difficulties of philosophy not of fact. If we think first of the larger union, we will have to include with the Presbyterians, Congregationalists, and Methodists, the Church of England and the Baptists.

As there are only three forms of government possible for a nation so there are only three forms of government possible for a church. The supreme authority must lodge somewhere, either in an individual, in a select few or in the masses.

The Church of England is not only a hierarchy, holding that the Episcopal form of church government (which she has a perfect right to hold) but insists upon being the only form of church government, and without it there is no church at all.

The next great difficulties to union must be sought in the doctrines of the different denominations. It has been said already that Creeds and Theologies are philosophy pure and simple.

terian, and Congregational Churches, which ought in any way to obstruct the union of these three. I want now to say in conclusion that the world owes much to these two great systems of philosophy, Calvinism and Arminianism. Calvinism sets out with the assumption of God's awful Sovereignty, and by the sheer force of logic necessarily concludes the freedom of the human will; but it has taught Arminianism to discuss the doctrines of the Church of England as it seems to me the theory of Apostolic Succession raises a barrier to any form of union; and the Baptist conception of baptism seems to raise as well an insurmountable barrier for the present, but time is a great modifier and what may occur in the future it is not safe to predict.

I do not think the union of the Methodist, Presbyterian, and Congregational Churches is a necessity in the Maritime Provinces perhaps not in Ontario. All the churches are well equipped for their work, and prepared to carry it forward along their own lines of action. They have their own Educational Institutions, their own Missionary organizations, well equipped and doing excellent work.
