MAJOR NAZIS INDICTED ON MANY COUNTS

Goering's Name Heads List of 24 Arch War Criminals

By ELTON C. FAY WASHINGTON, Oct. 18—(AP) The Allies indicted Hitler's henchmen today for a quarter-century of conspiracy culminating in the world's worst war and the mass murder of 10,000,000 men, women and children.

Specifically accused before the war crimes court are 24 individuals — Hermann Goering's name led all the rest — and six organizations. The indictment said the Nazi party, with Adolf Hitler assuming leadership in 1921, was the instrument of cohesion for the conspirators, it traced the evolution of the plot against mankind to that time.

The accusers who will prosecute their case before the international military tribunal sitting in the ancient German city of Nuremberg were the prosecutors for the four major Allied powers: Great Britain, the United States, Russia and France.

Count 1: The common plan or conspiracy to overthrow the Treaty of Versailles, rearm Germany, acquire "Lebensraum" at the expense of neighbor-countries and do this by any means including "force and aggressive war." Count 2: Crimes against peace, in which "all the defendants with divers other persons" were guilty in planning and then waging wars against Poland, Britain, France, Denmark, Norway, Belgium, Holland, Luxembourg, Yugoslavia, Greece, Russia and the United States.

and intimate friend of Hitler; indicted on all counts. Hans Frank, Nazi Governor-General of Polish territories; indicted on counts 1, 2 and 4. Martin Bormann, chief of the Nazi "S.A." Storm Troopers and head of the Volkswartung (People's Army), indicted on counts 1, 3 and 4.

Wilhelm Frick, Nazi "Protector" for Bohemia and Moravia; indicted on all counts, particularly for crimes in occupied territories. Fritz Sauckel, "S.S." and "S.A." general; indicted on all counts, charged particularly with "forcing inhabitants of occupied countries to work as slave laborers."

Albert Speer, Nazi armaments and Munitions Minister; indicted on all counts, charged particularly with "the abuse and exploitation of human beings for forced labor in the conduct of aggressive war."

Arthur Seyss-Inquart, former Nazi Chancellor of Austria, later Commissioner for the Netherlands; indicted on all counts, charged with promoting "seizure and consolidation" of Nazi control over Austria.

Julius Streicher, a General of the anti-Jewish paper, "Der Sturmer" quoted as saying: "The sun will not shine on the nations of the earth until the last Jew is dead"; indicted on counts 1 and 4.

Hans Fritzsche, Nazi editor and propagandist; indicted on counts 1, 3 and 4, charged particularly with "anti-Jewish measures and the ruthless exploitation of occupied territories."

Constantin von Neurath, former Nazi Foreign Minister, later "Protector" for Bohemia and Moravia; indicted on counts 1, 2 and 4.

Baldur von Schirach, head of Hitler youth movement; indicted on counts 2 and 4.

Of the 24 only these five were not listed as members of the Nazi party.

Major Nazis Indicted The indictment lists only the names of major Nazis in the hands of the Allies and ready for trial; it does not include the names of Hitler as defendant. Whether this is in accordance with the legal form agreed upon by the court or whether it reflects official belief that Hitler is dead is not immediately clear.

Along with Goering, at one time successor-designate to Hitler, are indicted seven names made news in European capitals during and long before the Second Great War. Some, like Goering, are named on all four counts; others, like Franz Papen, who became Hitler's ambassador, face only some of the counts.

ministers; members of defence council and secret cabinet council; indicted on all counts. The Nazi party leadership corps, including party officers, territorial leaders and the like; indicted on all counts.

The "S.S." or Nazi Elite Corps, originally a protective guard for Hitler and Nazi leaders, later developed into both a repressive police force and as an auxiliary to German armed forces; one department, called "S.D.," which operated a vast spy system, also mentioned in indictment; indicted on counts 1, 2 and 4.

The Gestapo, or Nazi Secret State Police; indicted on all counts. The "S.A." or Nazi Storm Trooper organizations; indicted on all counts.

The general staff and high command of the German armed forces, consisting of the officers who held the highest army, navy and air force commands between February, 1938, and May, 1945; indicted on all counts.
