HAYWOOD, THE BRAINS OF THE I. W. W.

Uncle Sam has dealt sternly and effectively with a menace which threatened to seriously hamper his war activities, namely, the conspiracy of the Independent Workers of the World.

Haywood first came into national and even international fame when he was accused by Harry Orchard of having planned the murder of ex-Governor Steunenberg, of Idaho, on December 30, 1905.

The task of worming the truth out of Orchard and he wrestled with the prisoner with the result that he made a long and detailed confession. He admitted that he had planted the bomb that killed Steunenberg, but said that he was merely an agent of Haywood's.

Socialist Propaganda

Haywood, Moyer and Pettibone, officials of the I. W. W., he said, had paid him for these assassinations. The defence of Haywood was that there was nothing to implicate him except Orchard's confession, and he sought to show that Orchard had been deprived of a mine by Steunenberg when Governor of the State, and that he had therefore a sufficient motive.

A Self-made Outlaw

Haywood was born in Utah, and came of a family of miners. At the age of 11 he was "bound out" to a

farmer, but ran away and got a job in the mines. He educated himself and acquired a respectable knowledge of mining both from text-books and by hard experience. He prospected in several states, and when the Western Federation of Miners was started in Idaho he was on the job, and was made assistant secretary.

Thrown Out by Socialists

After the Coeur d'Alene strike the headquarters of the Western Federation of Miners was shifted to Denver, and Haywood was made secretary-treasurer. The next few years were years of murder and violence in various Colorado mining camps, and his mine-owners did not hesitate to accuse Haywood of being responsible for many crimes.

RIGID PHYSICAL EXAM FOR RETURNED MEN

Veterans Examined As Carefully As Recruits On Return To Canada and Civil Life

To get into the army is one thing, and to get out is another, but the process is the same—a physical examination that takes count of every hair on a man's head, and leaves absolutely nothing to conjecture.

While the physicians are examining hundreds of young men liable to draft for the new army, others in the Discharge Depots of the Military Hospitals Commission are going over the units and misfits returned to Canada after service, with the same appraising eye.

For the protection of the man as well as the country, every precaution is taken that a man shall be restored to the best possible shape before he

is discharged from service to civil life. No chances are taken with incompetent ailments which might be overlooked by a cursory examination. The man who returns is striped and thoroughly examined, every wound recorded, and the exact state of his health noted on records which are filed in the department headquarters.

Unknown Weakness

An man whose disability is due primarily to the amputation of an arm or leg, may have contracted other weaknesses from service which could be remedied by treatment before his discharge. He may be ignorant of the condition himself, but it becomes immediately evident to the physician.

On the other hand in future years the man suffer from some disease which he will be due to other causes. The exact record of his health at the time of discharge will determine what basis there is for such a claim, if there is any.

The M. O's at the Discharge Depots examine about 100 men a day in this way, and upon their report and recommendation the interviewers whose business it is to take a man's vocational history and make recommendations for his vocational retraining if such a course is necessary, base their advice.
