 mentioning the grandson's name.
 Anyway William Lyon MacKenzie
 started a rebellion in Upper
 Canada. The show ran a pretty
 lively course in both provinces un-
 til both the rebel leaders left the
 country for their country's good.

Shortly after these two rebel-
 lions Upper Canada and Lower
 Canada concluded that union would
 be a good thing and that they
 would have only one Parliament
 for the two provinces. But it is one
 thing to get married and quite an-
 other thing to keep house together.
 They tried to keep house in King-
 ston, and in Quebec and Montreal
 but quarreled all the time. While
 Montreal was their head quarters
 a savage mob insulted the Govern-
 or General, bespattered him with
 rotten eggs and one miscreant
 leaped on his carriage and tried to
 kill him with an axe. Then they
 broke the windows in the Parlia-
 ment building and finally burned
 it to the ground. That was in 1839
 and it nearly broke up union house-
 keeping altogether. These re-
 bellions and insurrections are
 a bad thing, especially when they
 become established as a habit.
