LEADS THE YOUNG ASTRAY.

Judge Chequet, of the Juvenile Court stated yesterday that fully ninety-five per cent of the cases of theft, which came before him, were directly the result of a desire on the part of the delinquents to go to the picture shows and to smoke cigarettes.

He said the moving picture houses are a very real evil, and I am looking into the law to see what can be done to make it an offence to allow children under fourteen years of age to be admitted. The judge said that he was absolutely astonished at the hold which the moving picture show has on the children. He said that nowadays it seemed as though the boys must

have the picture shows and cigarettes, and were willing to steal gratuitously both desires.

He hopes to have the chief of police detail some men to watch the picture houses and see if they can stop the practice of admitting children under the legal age. The judge stated that the work of the Juvenile Court was running smoothly, and that about ten of the forty cases on the list had been disposed of. No final disposition of any case was made until after the court committee had discussed the case with him, and all the details with reference to the delinquent's home and environment had been laid before him. His Lordship said that he had one youth before him recently who was a cocaine fiend. He said the pool rooms were a source of great danger to the boys.
