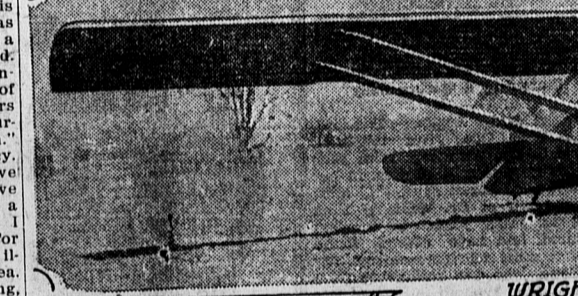
Diamond Sculls Finalist Takes Singles Championship
