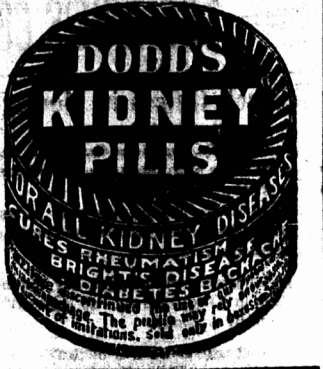

CANADA IS TO REVIVE GAELIC

OTTAWA, May 2.—The Ottawa Gaelic Revival association held its usual weekly meeting in the university science hall last night. Among matters of interest noticed in the informal discussion following the language study was the death of Editor Meehan of the Irish-American, of New York, one of the founders of the Gaelic movement in America. Favorable mention was also made by Vice-President McGeoghegan of the success of the Aberdeen association in circulating sound literature among the settlers of the Canadian Northwest, and the Gaelic society promises its co-operation in the work.

The Ottawa branch of the United Irish League, whose president, Dr. Freeman, is a member of the Gaelic Revival association, will at its next meeting discuss ways and means to encourage the study of Irish in the city. It will cooperate in this regard with the Gaelic Revival association, in whose work it desires to help. The Gaelic leagues are to be invited to discuss matters with the members of the United Irish league with a view to ascertain the best methods of spreading the movement.
