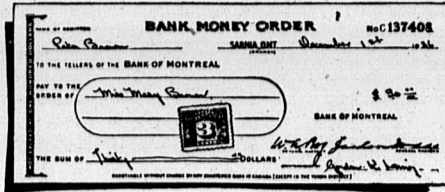

strike. Yesterday's market caused considerable skepticism regarding the immediate trend but we do not believe there was anything conclusive about the market. We believe the oil shares will continue in demand and would look for higher price in this group today. Also think the steel shares will be firm.

MINING

(C.P. by Guardian's Special Wire) TORONTO, Dec. 6—The oil stocks sounded the only strong note in Toronto mining section on Saturday. The metals were narrowly lower, both golds and base metals and Eldorado, the chief mover in the silver group, declined 8 cents to 2.25. Volume was off to 812,000 shares. Heaviness was displayed by the big golds. Dome closed at 50, down 1-2, McIntyre had the same loss and Lake Shore at 58 3-4 was off 1-4. Weakness, involving losses up to 10 cents, developed for Macassa, Pamour, Sladen and East Martlic. Perron was again in demand on news the company had run into high grade and the price recorded an advance of 7 cents. O'Brien improved 1-2, MacLeod-Cockshutt 10 cents and Little Long Lac advanced 35 to 7.25. Moderate weakness predominated in the base metals. Chromium sold down actively to a new low at 1.10 and recovered to 1.25 for a 5 cent loss. Chibougama dropped 15 cents.

MONTREAL, Dec. 6—(CP)—Egg prices declined on Montreal open produce markets last week while potatoes advanced. Butter and cheese ruled quiet and steady. Graded egg shipments in carlots or less were quoted at 40 cents a dozen for A-large, 31 to 32 for A-medium, 29 to 30 for A-pullets, 24 to 26 for B and 22 for C. Butter was quoted at 24 1-4 to 25 cents per pound for carlots or less of No. 1 while lots to retailers were 26 to 26 1-2 for solids and 26 1-2 for prints. Cheese was quoted at 12 3-4 to 13 for Ontario while Quebecs were unquoted. Potatoes: P.E.I. Mts. 90's \$1.55; N.B. Mts. 80's \$1.25; Que. Mts. 80's \$1.15.

NEW YORK, Dec. 5—(AP)—Raw sugar was unchanged today with spots quoted at 3.85, while 1937 futures were offered at 3.80. CHICAGO, Dec. 5—(AP)—Widespread light precipitation over United States spring and winter crop belts led to mostly lower prices for wheat today in Chicago. The Liverpool wheat market steadied during late dealings. Cables reported continued active demand for Argentine and Australian wheat both for Italy and Great Britain. Disappearance of wheat in the United States was reported officially as 15 per cent larger than a year ago. Wheat closed easy, at the same as yesterday's finish to 5-8 lower; Dec. 124 3-4 to 7-8; May 120 3-4 to 7-8; corn 3-8 off to 3-4 up; Dec. 107 3-8 to 1-2; May new 103 1-4 to 3-8; oats at 1-8 decline to an equal gain, and provisions varying from 15 cents setback to 5 cents advance.

"FREE TO CHOOSE" LONDON, Dec. 4—(Friday)—(CP Cable)—The Daily Express, published by the Canadian-born Lord Beaverbrook, commented for the first time today on the constitutional crisis and declared "the King is free to choose." "You must believe that he will choose wisely," the editorial said. "The King, through war and peace strife and stress has borne his part in the eyes of all men as a son of Kings should do and since he took the cloak of kingship he has deepened the channels of our emotions towards him. "Let the King give his decision to the people and the reasons for it too. Are we to lose the King or keep him? He knows the answer that the people want to hear, but it must not be goodbye for the citizens of these shores would say that word only with hearts loaded with grief and heads bowed with sorrow."
