A computation made by Dr. Leo Frank of the average prices realized for silver fox pelts at the Lampson & Co. sales in London held October 17th.

1918 shows the following facts. One pelt sold at one shilling (24 cents) classified as lot 1582.

Lot 1495 brought the record price of £240 or \$1200 for one pelt. This was a P. E. Island pelt from the Seal River Ranch.

The total amount realized at the sale

for 685 pelts was £25,169 equal to \$122,029 or average per pelt of \$155. If the pelts that realized \$100 or less had been eliminated the average would have been over \$300 per pelt.

Lampson's reports show that prices of silver fox pelts have advanced 60 per cent over last years prices.
