Congratulations to Montague on the opening of its railway. That busy, energetic town will now obtain a further impetus.

Railway disasters in England are fortunately few compared with what happen in America. English railways are proverbially safe, but express trains run at very high speed and in case of collision, or of a derailment such as occurred at Salisbury, the loss of life is terrible. Mr. Darwick, K. C. of Toronto, who was killed in the Salisbury disaster was head of the law firm of which Hon. A. B. Aylesworth is a member.

The Toronto Globe's Saturday Magazine contains a picture of the Fathers of Confederation in Conference at Quebec, with larger portraits of Sir Charles Tupper and Hon. A. A. Macdonald of this city, the only survivors of that distinguished body. Thirty-two of the thirty-three are dead.

The Liberal convention of Queen's County yesterday nominated ex-Judge A. B. Warburton and Hon. George W. Simpson as candidates for the next Dominion election. Horace Hazard, ex M. P., Hon. George E. Hughes, George E. Full and F. J. Nash, editor of The Patriot were also proposed as candidates. Mr. Hazard declined to allow his name to go before the convention, not believing it to be desirable to name the candidates at the present time. A letter was read from Mr. Nash, who is absent, declining to be a candidate. There is yet a good while before the term of the present Parliament will expire in regular course, and something might be said both for and against making nominations at the present time. The convention nominated the gentlemen first named in this paragraph. Both are earnest and forcible speakers, and have had experience in legislative and administrative work. Mr. Warburton as Premier and Mr. Simpson as a present member of the Executive. Together they represent rural and urban interests, country and town. At present the country has Conservative representatives but its past political history shows a number of changes.

THE MATTER OF VENDORS.

Sir,—A great disappointment prevails in temperance circles in Prince County re the personnel of the Government appointments to the vendership. Up to the present I have looked in vain for any plan outlined which they (or I may say we) desire followed. True it seems a sad state of affairs that any body of men would think for a moment of appointing men to that position who have proved themselves notorious law-breakers along those very lines. They cannot even hope for honest manly dealing in the future. If left in the hands of druggists it will be but a repetition of the old state of affairs; but perhaps either plan might be an improvement on the appointment of honest God-fearing temperance men, that is, if history repeats itself. It is bad enough to have an army of unprincipled money-grabbers to sink their fellows body and soul without tempting others to become so. There is to my mind one way by which to say the least, the curse might be reduced to the minimum: if officers received an appointment on salary, the Government to provide all goods, the appointee to be required to account to the Government for every drop placed under his control, while the whole matter should come under review in the Legislature just the same as all other revenue and expenditure; and in order that no temptation arise for Governments to push the trade in order to reimburse a depleted revenue, prices should be so arranged as to make the business self-sustaining and no more.

Before the Chief Justice, without a jury:

Gaudet vs. Hayes. Action of ejectment to recover possession of 12 acres of land at Fort Augustus. Tried on Wednesday, 27th June, when judgment was reserved. The Chief Justice yesterday morning read a decision in favor of the defendant and judgment was entered for him.

Before Mr. Justice Hodgson and a jury: Mahur vs. Walsh. This was an action by a father against the defendant, claiming damages for the alleged seduction of his daughter. The case occupied all day yesterday and resulted in the jury finding a verdict for the defendant.

The case of Hurry vs. McDonald. An action for libel will commence at eleven o'clock this morning.
