Num. 13: 1-3, 25, 33.
GOLDEN TEXT.
"If God is for us, who is against us?"—Rom. 8: 31.
POINTED SUGGESTIONS.

"Made in Canada," "Grown in Ontario," "Mined in British Columbia," "Raised in New Brunswick." It is interesting to inspect the exhibits which the provinces furnish for the fall fairs and other places of concourse or which are shown from coast to coast on exhibit tions cars and which advertise the merits of west lands, or clay belts, or northern territories, or eastern provinces, etc. The Lord God thought it was time that the children of Israel had an exhibit of the land of promise and eager interest aroused, and so He set Moses to the task.

And Moses went at it with all the system of a census bureau. Method is a good thing, and the methodical man often proves to be a very useful one. But the questions Moses put on his papers of inquiry for the report of the spies were sufficiently suggestive of possible difficulties to get faith squeezed so hard that it made room for distrust to go with it as a fellow-commissioner. The question is worth pondering: Did not Moses over-methodize the instructions he received when told to "send men that they may search the land of Canaan?"

Well, the report came back, all the papers filled out and exhibits of products to boot. One of an especial quality was among them. All the reports agreed upon essential matters, but when men ran their eyes up the

column with their own angle of vision and twist of interpretation they drew different conclusions. Mistrust produced figures which contradicted the estimates of faith.

The report of the spies split apart at the word "nevertheless." That is a word that is to be watched in any report. It may take you into sunlit heights or miasmatic bogs. It is the beginning of a journey either upon the right or wrong road for you. Make sure whether Mr. Nevertheless proposes to take you.

The majority report confirmed the fact that all that the Lord had said about the land of Canaan was true, but it added, "Nevertheless, the people be strong," etc. If faith had not been squeezed until its life had been taken their finding would have been deflected. It was even so with Caleb and Joshua, in whom faith had been kept alive.

Why was this encouraging statement which Caleb made so summarily shut off by the vociferations of his fellow-commissioners who presented the majority report? It was the bludgeon of the majority. The same instrument is often used, and it is neither more nor less than the assumption that it is right while the minority is wrong. It is the ugly force of brute majority. And it is never more ugly and never more brutal than when it is wielded by the disappointment or the disloyal.

Where God is counted in there are no giants. Stature, size, power, like the terms poverty and wealth, are relative. Tom, fourteen years old, is a giant to his brother Joe, six years old, until father enters the game with a return of his old athletic genius and tosses Tom over the fence. Why did the spies, unlike Caleb and Joshua, fail to take the Lord, who brought them out of Egypt, into the reckoning? That would have made every Israelite appear taller stouter and more powerful and every son of Anak a common man.

What are the giants which keep back the timorous church from its inheritance? Whatever they are, listen to any Caleb, and follow him who says in the name of God, "Let us go at once and possess it; for we are well able to overcome it."

It does not take many words to announce the death and burial of anyone, and very few suffice to tell that Mariam, the sister of Moses, has passed beyond these mortal scenes. But her death could not fail to profoundly influence the thoughts of her brother. Many words would not avail to tell them. Had they anything to do with the changed spirit with which he met the complaints of the congregation? It is easy for a sad soul to become a petulant and impatient one.

The absence of water makes a serious outlook, no matter how favorable all other conditions may be. But history does not need to repeat itself as though no lesson of the wisdom or power of God could ever be learned. The Lord had met the necessities of the people at every turn in the way. Why could they not wait upon Him now in the present need and crisis without wrath or doubting?

The chronic complainer has his own drone, monotonous and utterly wearisome. Songs of thanksgiving, praise songs, the music of victory have in them the notes of melody, which leap and thrill and tinkle and volumnously swell. But the mutterings and mumbblings of pessimistic complainers are tiresomely tame, flat and unprofitable. The refrain is attached to these words, "The good old days in Egypt." What

good old days or what good old circuit are you droning about? Moses and Aaron heard the people, and it appears that they went before God with their complaints reverently enough. The glory of Jehovah appeared unto them while they were humbly and worshipfully upon their faces. Take this, therefore, out of the heart of the lesson: God meets the lowly soul; the lowly and the contrite heart He does not despise. He shows unto such His glory and lifts them up.

But Moses and Aaron climbed too high on account of the answer God gave them and the victory it meant. It was the case of the pupil who forgets his teacher, and of the boy who forgets his mother, and of the prosperous one who forgets his benefactor when success comes. It is a wrong spirit, and wrong to the utmost measure of its egotism.

The use of means which human agency can employ is the method which it has many times pleased Almighty God to honor for the procuring of results which were none the less miraculous. It was so with the use of the rod in the hands of Moses. And he must have known it. He did know it. His arrogant speech, therefore, was bluff and rant and folly—a howling.

The moment anyone fails to honor God his mood is such that he is quite likely to utter unworthy speech with his tongue. The charge against Moses is that he believed not God to sanctify him in the eyes of the children of Israel. His impatient and vindictive words, "Ye rebels," were easy after that. Blatant talkers, swearers, profane persons are, at bottom, unbelievers in heart. Reverence is the most effective check to anger. It is at the root of right living and right action.

It is significant that the sin of Moses occurred through the breakdown of what may be called his strongest point. His patience, meekness, self-control failed him. Had he come to trust in himself? God mercifully relieved him of his leadership and by rebuke He saved him.
