## LIKELY TO BE NEXT MAYOR OF MONTREAL

MONTREAL, Dec. 28.—It is understood that Dr. J. Guerin, ex-M. L. A., who was for some time a member of the provincial government, is to be endorsed by the citizens association as the next mayor of Montreal, with F. L. Franklin, as the English speaking member of the board of control. This choice was made as it is the turn for an English speaking mayor, while the Irish Catholics are clamoring that it is their turn for a mayor. Also as the eucharistic congress is to be held here next year, it was considered advisable to have an English speaking Catholic, as chief magistrate.

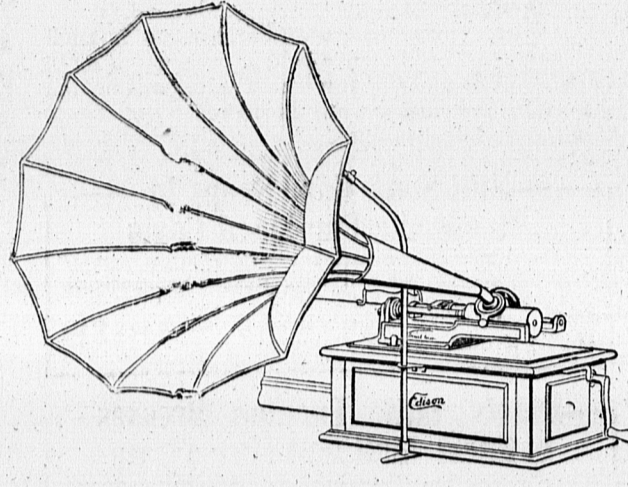

The cause of numerous diseases, and dangerous habits, heretofore ascribed to the teeth, have been traced directly to the teeth. Blotches, drooping, itching, loss of flesh, weak eyes, driving on one side, and pulling are very often due to diseased and irregular teeth. Rough edges and sharp corners of the teeth lacerate the mouth, and produce nervousness and irritability; uneven and elongated molars and incisors prevent the proper mastication of the food, producing indigestion and general debility. Decayed molars cause necrosis of the bone, abscesses, nasal discharges, etc. These causes should be removed. Decayed teeth should be removed by extracting or trepanning, sharp corners and edges should be smoothed down and elongated and uneven molars and incisors cut off. The common float, or file heretofore deemed sufficient to accomplish this, will not suffice. Special instruments devised for the purpose are necessary.
