Western Farmers Again Favored Under Policy Of King Government

OTTAWA, April 24 (Special) - Farmers in Europe and Asia are bringing prosperity to the wheat farmer of the Canadian west unparallelled since the days when wheat prices rode skyhigh in 1920. ...

Although the wheat grower of the Prairies complains that he should get the world price of \$2 a bushel Canadian funds for the current crop of \$1.25 plus a participation certificate worth about 30 cents additional means that every farmer with a good sized wheat farm will be paying income tax for 1946. ...

The boom in wheat exports as decreed by the government means that the proportion of export to domestic wheat is very large and that the price received by the wheat grower delivered at the Lakehead for first quality grain will be in the vicinity of \$1.50. ...

Sharp Contrast - This stands out in sharp contrast to the 80 cent wheat of years immediately prior to the war or the 90 cent wheat of 1942. ...

Prime Minister King's decision to release reserve stocks of grain for export shipment is described by friends and adversaries alike in this capital as the smartest political stroke of prouder years. Canada's Share Of Germany's Shipping

BRUSSELS, April 22 (Reuters) - Canada will get about 11,000 gross tons of the German merchant marine seized for reparations under a decision of the inter-Allied reparations agency announced today. ...
