BERLIN, Feb. 12—Dr. Solf, the new secretary of state for the colonies, has issued an order forbidding for the future all marriages between whites and natives in the Samoan Islands, belonging to Germany.

The order comes as a culmination of a long agitation against mixed marriages into which a large proportion of the imperial officials in German Samoa have entered and which were tolerated and even protected by former administrations in the colonial office.

The institution is now regarded as a danger to German prestige in the islands and even as a menace to the future of the colony as, according to the official standpoint, while colonists later marrying with natives very often sink to the lower cultural level of the aboriginal population...

TWENTY-FOUR HOURS OF PRAYER IN RELAYS.

BRANTFORD, Ont., February 12—A prayer of twenty-four hours' duration taken up in relays of fifteen minutes each was commenced here last night under the auspices of the men and religion forward movement. The ninety-six prayers will be concluded at nine o'clock tonight.

BLOWN FROM THE CAB.

ELIZABETH, N. J., February 12—John Adder, engineer, and Joseph Fitzsimmons were literally blown out of the cab of a freight locomotive here today by the explosion of a fire. They were picked up unconscious and it is believed that the fireman cannot live. The locomotive was going slowly at the time and stopped when the pipe burst. Burning coals scattered on the track, set fire to the ties and resulted in calling out the fire department.
